Since 1998, citizen observers, scientists and activists have been reporting on what appears to be a covert program of atmospheric spraying by fleets of military planes over the United States, Europe and other parts of the world. Although labeled as conspiracy theorists mistaking con-

trails for some secret evil, chemtrail activists have compiled a growing body of evidence and information to support their claims.

Contrails, caused by heated jet engine emissions hitting ice-cold air, persist for

only 20 minutes or less, whereas chemtrails often linger from horizon to horizon, spreading out to form artificial cirrus clouds. Also, lab-tested soil and water samples taken on California's Mount Shasta have shown an astounding increase in levels of barium and aluminum oxide in conjunction with chemtrail sightings. KC-10 tanker planes have been seen spraying in grid patterns.

In June 2010 Dave Kraft augmented the already abundant visual evidence when he captured B2 Stealth bombers laying down conspicuous trails over Moab, Utah. "After the three black jets flew out of sight, their trails merged into one large cloud that drifted east with the wind," Kraft recalled.

Two classified military projects are allegedly spraying barium salts in the atmosphere. (Barium enhances the propagation of radar waves.) One is the Navy's Radio Frequency Mission Planner program, which involves the 3-D radar imaging of a battlefield. The second is the High Frequency Active Auroral Research

Program (HAARP), which is using an array of microwave antennas in Alaska to heat the ionosphere. (See article that follows.) This was the patented brainchild of the late physicist Bernard J. Eastlund, who proposed releasing large clouds of barium to excite electrical particles in the atmosphere and thus alter weather patterns over a certain region.

Some barium salts are toxic. That these can weaken a person's immune system suggests another, more malign or paranoid reason for the spraying: thinning the herd. Testing such capabilities would not be inconsistent with the Pentagon's long record of conducting biowar and radioactive experiments on unwitting civilian populations both within and outside the United States.

Alternatively, a more benign theory holds that the mysterious spraying is a climate-engineering program to mitigate global warming and ozone depletion. In 1991 the Hughes Aircraft Company obtained a patent for the mitigation of global warming by seeding the stratosphere with metallic aerosols, particularly aluminum oxide. The idea was even publicly encouraged in 1997 by Edward Teller, father of the hydrogen bomb and director emeritus of the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratories. Aluminum has been implicated as a possible cause of Alzheimer's disease.

The truth may be a mixture of some or all these scenarios. One clue is "Weather as a Force Multiplier: Owning the Weather in 2025," an Air Force research paper published in 1996. It proposed studies for modifying weather to enhance

military operations. In its ongoing battle with Congress and the Constitution, the Pentagon has often reverted to covert action when the votes have gone against it. That may be the case with chemtrails as a component of weather warfare.

In 2002 Congressman Dennis Kucinich (D-Ohio) introduced H.R. 3616, the Space Preservation Act, which proposed making the atmosphere and outer space, like Antarctica, a weapons-free zone. The initial draft specifically cited "chemtrails," but that was soon rescinded, and the bill eventually died on the vine. Then in 2005 Senator Kay Bailey Hutchison (R-Texas) introduced the Weather Modification Research and Technology Transfer Authorization Act—apparently a move to establish civilian authority over classified programs like the Air Force's "Owning the Weather in 2025" position paper.

It too withered away after a polite letter of censure from John Marburger, director of President George W. Bush's Office of Science and Technology Policy: "The Administration respectfully requests that you defer further consideration of the bill pending the outcome of an interagency discussion of these issues that the Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) would coordinate—with the Department of Justice on legal issues, with the Department of State on foreign policy implications, with the departments of Defense and State on national security implications, and with pertinent research agencies to consider the reasons the U.S. Government previously halted its work in this area."

In keeping with the above gibberish, the assertion that this research was halted is very likely a fig leaf. What stakes could the Justice, Defense and State departments all have in the game? For Justice, a possible epidemic of lawsuits against the federal government by citizens suffering health problems, mostly respiratory, from chemtrail fallout. For Defense, the habitual imperative to keep its empire as thoroughly classified as possible.

For State, the diplomatic problem of explaining why the USA is violating yet another international treaty: the U.N. Convention on the Prohibition of Military or Any Other Hostile Use of Environmental Modification Techniques, ratified in 1978 under President Jimmy Carter.

All these problems vanish, of course, if chemtrails can be plausibly denied as a figment of the tin-foil hat crowd's imagination. As with so many other denials from our Orwellian government, the question arises: Who are you going to believe—the White House or your own lying eyes?

Whether for hostile purposes or benevolent climate management, weather modification technology is definitely evolving. If 5,000 years of history are any guide, the military is sure to be in the vanguard, devising ever more novel weapons of mass destruction best incubated in secrecy.

During 1997's Conference on Terrorism, Weapons of Mass Destruction and U.S. Strategy, then-Secretary of Defense William Cohen made a startling admission about the state of such research: "Others are engaging even in an eco-type of terrorism whereby they can alter the climate, set off earthquakes, volcanoes remotely through the use of electromagnetic waves.

... It's real, and that's the reason why we have to intensify our efforts."

One year later our skies began being painted with chemtrails.
